

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing Nanlite product -- PavoSlim 60C!

The newly designed LED RGBWW Panel light is ready for you. It has CCT, HSI, RGBW, Gel and Effect modes built-in, with color temperature from 2700K to 7500K, ±150 G/M adjustment, 151 gels, 15 effects and various color choices. It provides multiple power options by equipped with AC socket, NP-F and V-mount battery holder, together with control methods of on-board, Nanlink App, DMX/RDM and LumenRadio CRMX, making it serve as a valuable tool for professional-grade production scenes. The included softbox, diffuser and eggcrate will further unleash users' creativity. With slim and lightweight fixture body of 1×1" size, PavoSlim 60C is particularly suitable for small space, run & gun situations, providing a great help on content creation, commercial, film and television production lighting setup.

Notice

- 1. Please do not look directly at the emitter when the fixture is on.
- 2. Please do not place any object on the fixture or allow liquid to flow inside the fixture.
- 3. Please do not place the fixture near any flammable or volatile substances like alcohol or gasoline.
- 4. Please do not use strong detergent for cleaning. Please wipe off the dirt by using a cloth with neutral cleanser when cleaning the fixture.
- 5. Please set up the fixture in a dry and well-ventilated place. Please do not use it in any humid, dusty or overheated environment. Meanwhile, please also check whether the fan and vent are unimpeded.
- 6. Please do not disassemble the fixture to repair at will. Qualified professionals should conduct maintenance under the condition of strictly following the operating procedures described in this manual.
- 7. Please do not cover the vents when using, to avoid affecting heat dissipation, and resulting in damage. Please pay attention to anti-scald when using the fixture for a long time, since the surface temperature of fixture will be high.





Detailed Description

- 1. USB Port: For updating firmware.
- 2. NP-F Battery Holder: For mounting the NP-F batteries.
- 3. Display Screen: For displaying datas.
- 4. Control Panel: For displaying various function operations and datas.
- 5. Quick Release Plate: For mounting the quick release clamp.
- 6. Battery Holder: For mounting the V-mount battery.
- 7. Baby Pin Holder: For securing the fixture body and adjusting based on axial angles.
- 8. Universal Holder: For securing the fixture body and adjusting to any angle.
- 9. DC Output Socket: To connect the DC cable for connecting between the fixture body and control unit.
- 10. AC Power Input Socket: To connect the AC power cable to power the control unit.
- 11. Power Switch: To turn on/off the fixture.
- 12. DMX In/Out: Connect to DMX adapter cable for DMX signal input and output. (Note: DMX adapter cable is sold separately).





Usage

1. Connection Between Light Fixture, Control Unit and Power Supply.




Note:

- 1.1. When connecting the power supply, please make sure the power voltage is consistent with that indicated on the control unit.
- 1.2. Make sure to use the included AC power cable and control unit. The connection between the DC output socket and the DC connection cable from the fixture body should be done as shown above.



2. Connection Between Light Fixture and Control Unit with Battery




Turn off the power switch before installing the battery on the battery holder of the control unit.

- 2.1 Please do not exert too much force when mounting the battery, to avoid damage and deformation of the battery holder.
- 2.2 Please press the battery lock catch when removing the battery, to avoid damage of the battery holder.
- 2.3 NP-F battery holder is for mounting NP-F batteries.
- 2.4 V-mount battery holder is for mounting 14.4-14.8V or 26V V-mount batteries.




3. Installation and Detachment of Quick Release Clamp




Rotate the adjustable handle to release the clamp.



Mount the quick release clamp on the light stand, then rotate the adjustable handle to tighten the clamp.




Align the quick release plate on the control unit with the quick release mount on the clamp to mount the control unit on to the clamp.



Press the lock catch on the clamp to remove the control unit from the light stand.




- 4. Installation of Softbox and Diffuser
- 4.1 Installation and Storage of Softbox




①Set the softbox upright, wrap it around the fixture and stick at the interface.

②Fasten the hook and loop fasteners to the back of fixture.



3 After use, flatten the softbox and fasten the hook and loop fasteners on both sides to the back of fixture for storage.




4.2 Installation of Diffuser and Eggcrate




①Tear open the hook and loop fasteners on both sides, and set the softbox upright.

Note: There are included two diffusers: lite diffuser and standard diffuser.






5. Installation and Detachment of Universal Holder and Baby Pin Holder



5.1 Align to the icons that on the back of fixture and follow the direction shown as the picture to install the universal holder.





- 5.2 Pull up the knob of the universal holder, and slide the universal holder in the direction shown as picture above to remove it from the fixture.
- \cdot The installation and detachment method of baby pin holder is the same as that of universal holder.



Remote Control

- ·PavoSlim 60C supports DMX/RDM, 2.4G and LumenRadio remote control, and it also has built-in Bluetooth module.
- ▲The address needs to be set before operating the remote control via DMX/RDM, 2.4G and LumenRadio.
- ADDRESS/DMX Seting, including ADDRESS, DMX MODE, DMX REDUCED CHANNELS, DMX DIMMING CURVE and DMX SMOOTHING.
- 1.1 ADDRESS Setting

Press the MENU button to enter the menu.














Rotate the right knob to ADDRESS/DMX, and press the right knob to enter the secondary menu.



Rotate the right knob to ADDRESS, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.




Note: PavoSlim 60C has 20 channels, for multiple lights remote control via DMX/RDM and LumenRadio, the address of the first light should be set to 001, the second one to 021, the third one to 041, and so on.

Rotate the right knob to DMX MODE, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.







1.4 DMX DIMMING CURVE



Rotate the right knob to DMX DIMMING CURVE, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.







1.5 DMX SMOOTHING



Rotate the right knob to DMX SMOOTHING, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.





Rotate the right knob to select ON or OFF, and press the right knob to set.

- 2. DMX Control
- 2.1 Connect the fixture to the DMX/RDM consoles via DMX cable as shown below:



- ·5-pin shielded cable with a diameter not less than 0.3mm must be used for connection between light fixture and DMX/RDM console, or between light fixture and light fixture. XLR plug/socket and the cable should be connected as shown above.
- ·Pin1, Pin2, Pin3 for connecting DMX signal. Pin4, Pin5 have no connection.




▲ NOTE: When connecting DMX, make sure the internal pin is not in contact with the inner case, and pins should not be in contact with each other.

The fixture can match the DMX512 (1990) control signal.

·5-pin and 3-pin XLR plug/socket conversion

The fixture comes with 5-pin XLR plug/socket. If a 3-pin XLR plug is used, please follow the instruction below.




2.2 DMX Terminator

In DMX control mode, the DMX output of the last light fixture should be connected with a DMX terminator (not included).

The terminator is connected with a $120\Omega(OHM)$ resistor across Pin 2 and Pin 3 (As shown below).

This prevents interference caused by DMX signals in the transmitting process.



DMX Terminator Connection Connect a 120Ω(OHM) resistor across Pin 2 and Pin 3 in an XLR plug and insert into the DMX OUT socket on the last unit.





- 3.1 Connect the light fixture to the console with RDM function by using a connection cable, the connecting method is the same as that of DMX/RDM console.
- 3.2 Control the fixture via a console with RDM function. (For specific operation methods, please refer to the RDM console operation manual.)



- 4 WIRELESS CONTROL
- 4.1 Bluetooth Setting

PavoSlim 60C has built-in Bluetooth function for connection via Bluetooth.



Rotate the right knob to WIRELESS CONTROL, and press the right knob to enter the secondary menu.



Rotate the right knob to BLUETOOTH SETTINGS, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.











4.2 2.4G Setting

PavoSlim 60C can be remotely controlled by 2.4G remote controller or by Nanlink App via the WS-TB-1 transmitter box. Note: ①2.4G remote controller and WS-TB-1 transmitter box are sold separately.

② PavoSlim 60C supports the 2.4G wireless protocol V1.0 and V2.0. The fixture should be set in V2.0 while using WS-RC-C2 remote controller, set in V1.0 while using other remote controllers.




Rotate the right knob to 2.4G SETTINGS, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.



Rotate the right knob to 2.4G ON/OFF, and press the right knob to enter the next menu.






Rotate the right knob to select ON or OFF, and press the right knob to set. The 2.4G wireless control is available when the 2.4G is set to be on.



Rotate the right knob to WIRELESS PROTOCOL, and press the right knob to enter the next menu.





Rotate the right knob to select V1.0 or V2.0, and press the right knob to set.

4.3 LumenRadio Setting


PavoSlim 60C has built-in TIMO RX module, enabling it to receive CRMX wireless DMX signals. The specific operations are as below:

① Set the fixtures that need to receive CRMX wireless DMX signals to unlink.



Rotate the right knob to WIRELESS CONTROL, and press the right knob to enter the secondary menu.






Rotate the right knob to LUMENRADIO SETTINGS, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.





Rotate the right knob to select ON or OFF, and press the right knob to set.

The PavoSlim 60C can receive CRMX wireless DMX signals when the LumenRadio is set to be on.





② Connect and control the light fixture that set to transmitter mode or CRMX wireless DMX transmitter with the light fixture that needs to receive the CRMX wireless DMX signal.

Note: The light fixture can only be reconnected to the new fixtures or transmitters after set to unlink.



4.4 All Wireless On/Off



Rotate the right knob to WIRELESS CONTROL, and press the right knob to enter the secondary menu.



Rotate the right knob to ALL WIRELESS ON/OFF, and press the right knob to enter the tertiary menu.







Rotate the right knob to select ON or OFF, and press the right knob to set.


When all wireless functions are set to be on, the Bluetooth, 2.4G and LumenRadio settings will be in the ON state. When all wireless functions are set to be off, the Bluetooth, 2.4G and LumenRadio settings will be in the OFF state.




Operating Instructions

- 1. Make sure the control unit is off, connect with the fixture, and connect to mains electricity via the power cable or mount the battery, and turn on the power switch, the screen will display "NANLITE".
- 2. MODE button: Press the MODE button to enter the lighting mode interface.

(The lighting modes include CCT, HSI, RGBW, GEL and Effect modes.)









CCT MODE Setting: Rotate the right knob to select DIM, CCT (range: 2700K-7500K) or G/M (range: -150 to 150), then rotate the left knob and set the corresponding parameters.

2.2 HSI MODE

HSI MODE Setting: Rotate the right knob to select DIM, HUE (range: 0-360) or SAT (range: 0-100), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select DIM, HUE or SAT.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.

Note: In other modes, the adjustment range of HUE and SAT is the same as that in HSI Mode.



2.3 RGBW MODE

RGBW MODE Setting: Rotate the right knob to select red, green, blue or white, and rotate the left knob to adjust the DIM and the corresponding red, green, blue and white values (adjustment range: 0-255).



Rotate the right knob to select DIM, red, green, blue or white.



Rotate the left knob to adjust DIM and the corresponding red, green, blue and white values.



2.4 GEL MODE

GEL MODE Setting: Rotate the right knob to adjust the DIM, CCT (3200K or 5600K) and GEL, and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to adjust the DIM, CCT and GEL.




Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



2.5 FEFECT MODE

PavoSlim 60C has built-in effects including: HUE Loop, CCT Loop, INT Loop, Flash, Pulse, Storm Auto, Storm Manual, Police Car, TV, Paparazzi, Candle/Fire, Disco, Bad Bulb, Firework, Explosion Auto, Explosion Manual and Welding.



Rotate the left knob to select the needed effect, which can be selected in a loop.




①HUE LOOP

HUE LOOP setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM, HUE, SAT or SPEED (range: 2s-30s), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select DIM, HUE, SAT or SPEED.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



②CCT LOOP

CCT LOOP setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM, CCT, G/M or SPEED (2s-30s), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.

Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



③INT LOOP

INT LOOP setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM and COLOR (including CCT and HSI).

When the color is CCT, rotate the right knob to select CCT, G/M or SPEED (range: 2s-30s), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select CCT, G/M or SPEED.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.

When the color is HSI, rotate the right knob to select HUE, SAT or SPEED (range: 2s -30s), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters (same operation method as in CCT).



@FLASH

FLASH setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM and COLOR (including CCT and HSI).

When the color is CCT, rotate the right knob to select CCT, G/M or INTERVALS (range: 0.1s-10.0s), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select CCT. G/M or INTERVALS.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.

When the color is HSI, rotate the right knob to select HUE, SAT or INTERVALS, and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters (same operation method as in CCT).



⑤PULSE

PULSE setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM and COLOR (including CCT and HSI).

When the color is CCT, rotate the right knob to select CCT, G/M or PULSES/MIN (range: 1-240), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select CCT. G/M or PULSES/MIN.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.

When the color is HSI, rotate the right knob to select HUE, SAT or PULSES/MIN (range: 1-240), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters (same operation method as in CCT).



@STORM AUTO

STORM AUTO setting, rotate the right knob to select DIM, CCT or INTERVAL RANGE (range: 1S-60S), and rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



Rotate the right knob to select DIM, CCT or INTERVAL RANGE.



Rotate the left knob to set the corresponding parameters.



@STORM MANUAL




Rotate the right knob to FIRMWARE UPDATE, press the right knob to enter the interface to search for the firmware files.

Note:

- ①Please do not rename the firmware files.
- @Ensure the USB drive is formatted to FAT. FAT32 or exFAT.
- ③If prompted that "NO FIRMWARE FOUND", please check whether the firmware files are correct, whether the firmware files are put in the root directory of the USB drive, or whether the USB drive format is FAT, FAT32 or exFAT.
- (4) If all the above steps are done and the firmware files still cannot be found, please format the USB drive again.
- (5) If the fixture still cannot identify the USB drive, please replace the USB drive.





After firmware file is found, enter the firmware update interface, rotate the right knob to select UPDATE, and press the right knob to make update. After update, the light fixture will automatically restart.


